 - Current unconditional "A" Class Western Australian driver's licence or the equivalent
 - Australian Citizenship or British Citizenship with permanent residency in Australia
 - Approved keyboard skills (approx 30 words per minute)
- #### Desirable
- (These criteria will be essential from 1 November 1996)
- Current Bronze Medallion
 - Current Senior First Aid Certificate

Selection process

Entry is very competitive and only the best applicants will be chosen. Selection depends upon many factors including:

- Character check
- Medical assessment
- Entrance evaluation
- Physical performance evaluation
- Selection interview
- Psychological interview
